## Seasons in Australia

### Summer - December through February

In summer, the average daily temperatures range from about 20°C to 37°C in the major capital cities.

### Autumn - March through May

Things start to cool down slightly in autumn, with temperature averages slipping to between 17°C and 35°C

### Winter - June through August

The winter months see average temperatures that range from 11°C in the south to 30°C in the north.

### Spring - September through November

Spring boasts average daily temperatures from 17°C and 35°C, from the south to the north, respectively.
